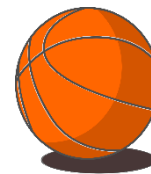

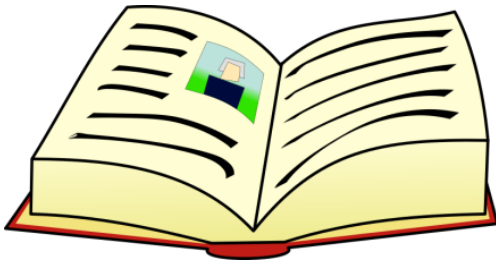
### Home Reading Challenge
