The high school sports year is now over. Please look for uniforms, wash them, and return them to the school. Missing jerseys result in a replacement fee charged to the family

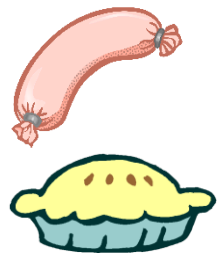

Tuition Update 2017

In order to streamline tuition payments, we require that all families sign up for pre-authorized tuition payments. This will help you and the school to save time and money by reducing the number of cheques.

Tuition will be paid in one of the following ways:

- pay the yearly tuition in a lump sum by September 30
- bring a void cheque to school from the account that you wish to pay tuition (tuition can be taken out on a 10 month or 12-month plan)
- If you do not have a cheque, request a form from your banking institution that has your banking information
- request an exception from the bookkeeper and Principal for an alternate method of payment.

Tuition for 2017/2018 has been set as follows:

Families with 1 child - \$6158

Families with 2 children - \$6615

Families with 3 or more children - \$6958
