Please note that we have moved our Early Dismissal date for June to Monday, June 25. It was originally scheduled for June 18.

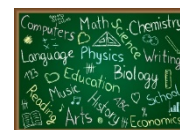

Tuition Update 2018

In order to streamline tuition payments, we require that all families sign up for pre-authorized tuition payments. This will help you and the school to save time and money by reducing the number of cheques.

Tuition will be paid in one of the following ways:

- pay the yearly tuition in a lump sum by September 30
- bring a void cheque to school from the account that you wish to pay tuition (tuition can be taken out on a 10 month or 12-month plan)
- If you do not have a cheque, request a form from your banking institution that has your banking information
- request an exception from the bookkeeper and Principal for an alternate method of payment.
