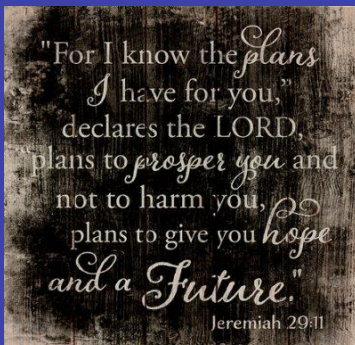

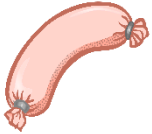
## \*2017 Pledge Drive\*
